Boating Skills and Seamanship Virtual Course

(English)

If you plan to own a boat, a jet ski or just learn about it, this is the perfect opportunity to get the license to be a recreational boating operator. This is the only course authorized by the USCG, Nasbla and the State Department of Natural Resources in order to qualify for a recreational boating operator permit. The permit issued by the State Department of Natural Resources, after passing the course; is the official way to command a recreational craft up to 65 feet in length on the Island.
