



BOATING SKILLS & SEAMANSHIP **ONLINE COURSE**

This course is the only authorized by the USCG, Nasbla, and the States Department of Natural Resources to qualify for a recreational boating operator permit. The permit issued by the State Department of Natural Resources, after passing the course is the official way to command a recreational craft up to 65 feet in length in the Island.

This online course lasts 11 days from June 13 to June 29. Class hours are Mon. to Thu. from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. All students are required to attend all classes and comply with the instructor's requirements to get certified. Class includes textbook & exam. Cost: \$89 per person/ note: there is an additional cost of \$15 per person collected by the DRNA for preparing the certificate.




