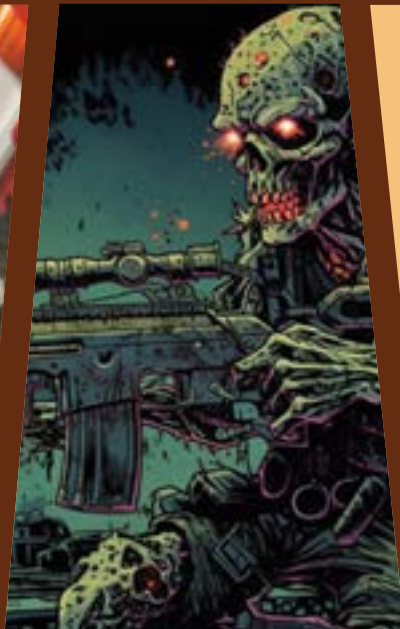

Fort Buchanan CYS Celebrates Young Lives, BIG Stories Contest Winner

For military children, change is often a familiar part of growing up. New schools, new friendships, deployments, reunions, and saying goodbye can become experiences that shape how they see themselves and the world around them. While these moments can be challenging, they also help develop resilience, adaptability, courage, and a unique sense of belonging.

Opportunities such as the Young Lives, Big Stories (YLBS) Contest give military-connected children a meaningful way to put those experiences into their own words and creative expressions. The contest recognizes that not every child communicates in the same way, allowing participants to share their personal stories through artwork, photography, videos, poems, essays, spoken word, and other creative formats. By offering different means of expression, children and youth can choose the format that best represents their personality, talents, emotions, and individual story.

This year, Camila Cano-Alva, a second-grade participant in the Fort Buchanan School Age Center (SAC) Program and a student at DoDEA Antilles Elementary School, demonstrated the power of that opportunity. Through her participation, Camila was able to share a piece of her experience as a military child and, in doing so, represent many other children whose lives are also shaped by military service.

Recognizing young storytellers like Camila is important because their words can encourage another military child who may be experiencing similar changes or emotions. Their stories can help families, educators, and communities better understand the military-child experience while reminding other children that they are not alone.

Programs and contests like YLBS do more than celebrate creativity. They give military children a platform to reflect, express themselves, connect with others, and inspire. Every military child carries a story worth hearing, and when we provide them with opportunities to share it, we also give them the confidence to recognize the strength within their own journey.
